Founded in 2015, this remarkable ensemble features young stars from three of the world's greatest orchestras: Noah Bendix-Balgley, first concertmaster of the Berlin Philharmonic; Shanshan Yao (Violin '08), concert violinist and former member of the Pittsburgh Symphony and New York Philharmonic; Teng Li (Viola '05), principal violist of the Los Angeles Philharmonic; and Nathan Vickery (Cello '13), cellist in the New York Philharmonic.

This phenomenal "Dream Quartet," continues to excite audiences with their distinctive sound and unanimity of expression.

Maya Anjali Buchanan, from Rapid City, S.D., a student of Ida Kavafian, is the Jill and Sheldon Bonovitz Fellow and entered Curtis in 2018.
